



To Round:

- ① Underline the place value that you are rounding to
- ② Look 1 digit to the right
  - If that digit is: 0, 1, 2, 3 or 4 →  
Keep the rounded digit the same
  - If that digit is: 5, 6, 7, 8, or 9 →  
Add 1 to the rounded digit (and carry if you need to)

### Rounding to a Whole Number

Drop the decimal point. Fill in to the right of the rounded digit with zeros.

### Rounding to a Decimal Place

The rounded digit will be your last digit in your new number. You must have a digit in your rounded position, even if it is zero.

492 to the hundreds → 500

1.0492 to the hundredths → 1.05

1.0492 to the tenths → 1.0

1.0492 to the ones → 1

998 to the tens → 1000

998 to the hundreds → 1000

0498 to the thousands → 0
