1. We will be using your MVMS google account to access your online textbook. You will not be able to use any personal account for access. What is your full school google user name (including the suffix, @stu.mvschools.org)

2. Now use your ipad to log on to our textbook. Once you have entered the website, click on the picture of the textbook. You will probably want the English version on the left. How many chapters are there in the book?

3. Click on Chapter 1. Click on **1.1.1**. You will see problem 1 – 1. There is a picture to the right of problem 1.1. What is the picture of?

4. Stay in Chapter 1. Return to the left of the screen and click on **Section 1.2.4**. Scroll down to problem 1–85. Read the problem and click on the word: **Homework Help**. Check the **hint** for problem b. What does the hint say?

5. Stay in Section 1.2.4 and scroll down to problem 1–88. The words "least common multiple" should be in blue. The definition should appear if you click on the words. What is the definition of least common multiple?

6. Return to the menu bar at the left of the screen, scroll down to the bottom and click on **Reference** below the chapter numbers. Click on **Checkpts**. Click on **CP–1**. It is a problem on Rounding. Read the checkpoint and give the answer to Example 2.

7. Return to the left (under Reference) and click on **Glossary**. What is the word and definition for the third entry in the Glossary?

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8. Return to the left and click on **Student Support**. Click on **Resource Pages** at the top. Click on the Resource Page for **Lesson 1.1.4A called Frog Jubilee**. Open the document. What was the Year and Jump length for the frog named Spare the Air Everyday?
